Hanö An enchanting island

The island of Hanö outside Listerlandet is surrounded by enchanting legends, like the "mark of the dragon". When Hanö lighthouse was lit up for the first time, the dragon was blinded and crashed into the rock-face below. In addition to legends, Hanö offers amazing real life experiences. such as the stone reef 'Bönsäcken' that consists of millions of water-polished stones, continuously moving and changing form with the storms, of huge boulders, grottos, grass fields and forests as well as flat rocks that are perfect for sunbathing and swimming. Hanö has a restaurant, a museum, accommodation, and an amazing guest harbour.



Sweden's southern-most wilderness A mecca for the adventurous

Olofström is Blekinge's inland municipality – no coastline but tons of adventures and wildlife experiences in the deep forests, on the lakes, rivers, and streams. Fishing, kayaking and canoeing, hiking, biking, and horseback riding ... just name your favourite type of outdoor adventure, Olofström has got it. Come and explore the inland outdoors!




Ronneby Brunnspark A health cure for the modern mind

A beautiful, award winning park and a living cultural reserve. The park in itself feels like a health cure. There are a lot of activities throughout the whole year; the charming Café Mandeltårtan, a flea market, music events, and festivals. In the 1870:s water from a spring in the park became very popular, and people from the whole country started travelling to Ronneby Brunnspark to drink it as a way to improve their health. ARK56 Connected coastal trails in a UNESCO biosphere reserve

ARK56 takes you through the Blekinge archipelago. A biosphere reserve is designated by UNESCO to serve as a model area for the sustainable development of its unique natural and cultural values. ARK56 stretches from Mörrum to Kristianopel. Just join any of the routes where it suits you, create your own trip, and change your mode of transport whenever you want. For example, you can cycle along the coast from Kristianopel, change to an archipelago boat at Hasslö, hike on Aspö, then kayak back to Kristianopel.



Eriksberg Hotel & Nature Reserve

Go on safari at Eriksberg and see wild animals in their proper environment. Red deer, fallow deer, Père David's deer, European bison, wild boar and mouflon freely roam around in this unique nature reserve in the archipelago; the largest game reserve in the Nordic. But Eriksberg is much more than a safari park. The hotel and the villas offer exclusive accommodation, a relax area and glamping – all with stunning views – gourmet restaurants, a lifestyle boutique, and a farm shop.

The prime spot for music lovers

Sweden Rock Festival. One of the world's most renowned music festivals takes place in Norje, out-side the town of Sölvesborg. Many of the giants of rock and metal come here to perform and meet the crowd – some 30 000 enthusiasts from all around the globe.

Hasslöfestivalen. A festival in a unique setting; the middle of Karlskrona's archipelago. Offers a perfect mix of legendary Swedish rock n' roll artists and the hottest new pop stars.

Hällevik Tradjazzfestival. This festival transforms the fishing village of Hällevik into New Orleans. Bands from all over the world.
